- 36 libraries
- 16 loans/inhabitant
- 11,3 visits/inhabitant

- 10 visits/inhabitant



urban workshop

- Low threshold maker space & laboratory for pilot projects, thinking & testing services. Situated in the center of Helsinki. Opened in 2013.
- The customers and partners were and are involved in planning the service.





BUT WHY IN THE LIBRARY?

LISTENING TO THE VOICE OF THE PEOPLE

• The service was wished by the citizens in participatory budgeting project. The residents decided in workshops which pilot projects would be launched. The maker space was one of the projects they wanted to come true.

EQUALITY & LEARNING

- A low threshold place to get familiar with new technology previously only available for very few. Like the Internet in the 90's.
- Libraries are easy to access and the service is free of charge. Only material costs are asked for. (E.g. 40 cents for a 3D print)
- You don't have to learn and do it alone: the staff is there to help.

SUPPORTING LOCAL ECONOMY

By supporting small scale entrepreneurs, library helps to boost the city economy. Library is a business hub for everyone, not just those who attended business school.

OUR GOAL: THE NEW CENTRAL LIBRARY, WILL BE OPENED IN DECEMBER 2018






The 3rd floor will be for books & other collection...



...the 1st floor will be great for getting inspired & meeting people...




... and the whole 2nd floor will be a big, well-equipped maker space and lots of raw working space for people.



SERVICES IN URBAN WORKSHOP

 Equipment: 3D printers, 3D scanner, vinyl cutter, 3D cutter, graphics station, badge maker, sewing machines + video editing, digitizing station and multimedia computers.





- Assistance in using all the available equipment - no prior experience needed.
- Help and tuition with IT-problems.



THE STAFF: HELPING THE CUSTOMERS TO DO IT THEMSELVES

- Mainly media workers and IT-specialists there's five of us altogether.
- Competence in technology matters but most important is the "Let's find out together"-attitude.
- Active role in developing the service.



SHARING THE SPACE: FROM OFFICE AREA TO OVERNIGHT MAKER WORKSHOPS

- 300 m2 of space that has to be easily converted according to the customers needs.
- Working in a protected building sets limitations but provides a beautiful backround for learning and creating!

 A wide range of customers from young, small scale entrepreneurs to old age pensioners - and everything in between.






THE PROJECTS: EVERYONE CAN BE A DESIGNER

WORKING TOGETHER WITH FRIENDS & PARTNERS


 Most of the events and workshops are organised by the users themselves, we help and facilitate.





WHAT HAVE WE GAINED & LEARNED?

- More customers, new customers, new kinds of customers: "urban activists", small scale entrepreneurs, designers, artists...
- Designing, making and creating is for everyone.
- Not all the information has to be learned from the books even in the library. You can learn also by doing. (Books are still great, too!)
- Giving the ownership of the space and facilities to its users is well worth the risks.
- Machines are fun and enable lots of things. But the most important, creative and complex gadget of any maker space is the human being on both sides of the library desk.
