# **E-PANEMA:** concept and solution

#### **Situation**

- Members would often ask us for help to find partners for their projects
  - Emails sent to all members
  - Informal talks
- Information about current and completed library projects in Europe is scattered and often hard to find

#### **Objectives**

- Help our members to find partnerships in a more independent, more immediate manner
- Centralised platform for EU-funded library projects
- Centralised platform with information about SDGs and specific topics (successor of the EBLIDA Matrix)



# **RL:EU Project: introduction**



- Partners: EBLIDA, PiNA, PL2030
- Co-funded by Erasmus+ as a cooperation project in adult education
- **Duration:** 2-year project, 3 months extension
- Full name: "Resourcing Libraries: connecting libraries to EU resources" (RL:EU)
- Objective: The project aims to help Europe's public libraries unlock EU resources to support their adult education programmes and strategies











# **RL:EU Project: resources**



- Research of public libraries' participation in EU programmes
- A series of 4 webinars
- Workbook for public libraries to access EU funds
- 25 local events (awareness raising and training)
- 100 mentorship hours 10 group coaching sessions
- European networking conference in 2024



#### **Local events**


- Awareness or training event adapted to your local needs;
- Presentations, discussions, exercises with specialists in EU funding;
- In-person or online;
- If possible, in your own language.





### 1-on-1 mentorship

- 1-on-1 session(s) with a EU funding specialist, tailored to your needs and questions;
- You can get more general information or help with a specific project proposal.



## **Group coaching**

- Group session with an EU funding specialist;
- The audience can ask questions and they are debated in a group.










# **RL:EU Project: upcoming resources**
