E-PANEMA: concept and solution

Situation

- Members would often **ask us for help** to find partners for their projects
 - Emails sent to all members
 - Informal talks
- Information about current and completed library projects in Europe is scattered and often **hard to find**

Objectives

- Help our members to find partnerships in a **more independent, more immediate** manner
- **Centralised platform** for EU-funded library projects
- Centralised platform with **information** about SDGs and specific topics (successor of the EBLIDA Matrix)

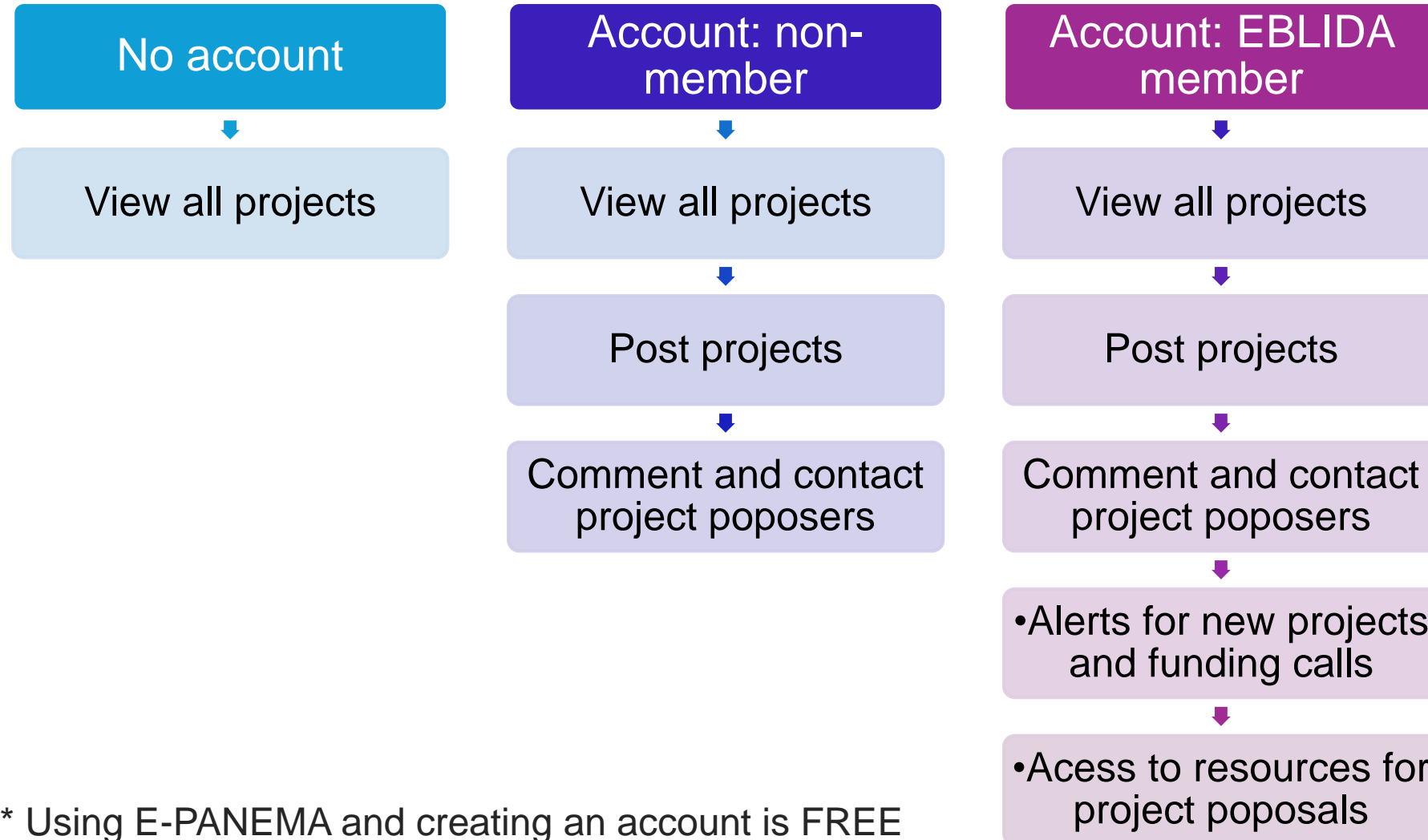

- **Partners:** EBLIDA, PiNA, PL2030
- **Co-funded by Erasmus+** as a cooperation project in adult education
- **Duration:** 2-year project, 3 months extension
- **Full name:** “Resourcing Libraries: connecting libraries to EU resources” (RL:EU)
- **Objective:** The project aims to help Europe’s public libraries unlock EU resources to support their adult education programmes and strategies

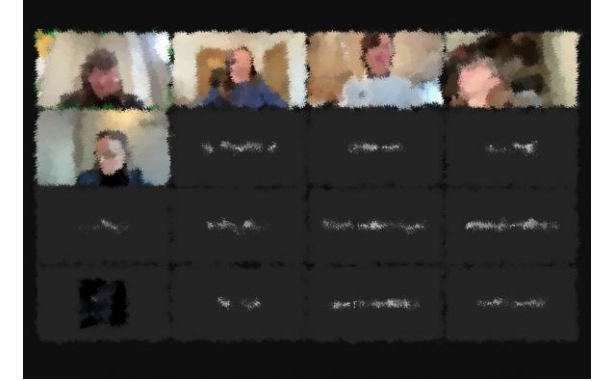
Local events

1-on-1 mentorship

- 1-on-1 session(s) with a EU funding specialist, tailored to your needs and questions;
- You can get more general information or help with a specific project proposal.



Group coaching

- Group session with an EU funding specialist;
- The audience can ask questions and they are debated in a group.



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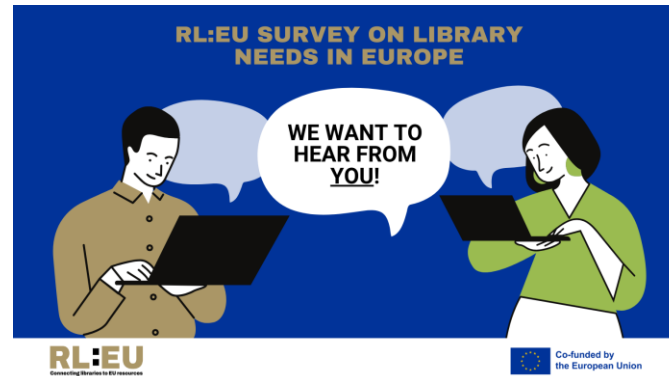
